Tier 2. Individual pupil level data – identifiable and sensitive

KS2, KS4, KS5 - matched all data linked to census – Academic year - 2014/2015

School Census - matched all data linked to census – Academic year 2014/2015

Spring Census to include birth month and year, census output area and SEN status

Special Educational & Needs Output Area

Special Educational Needs - as in Statemented/School Action Plus/School Action/None - to enable us to analyse, for schools with significant SEN populations, how well the school does by such pupils and, at LA level, how statementing works locally.

Output Area: for a number of years we have published maps of where pupils at each school come from geographically.

We have used Output Area to do this because Super Output Area produces a map that is too coarse to be useful to

parents who want to understand which schools they have a reasonable chance of getting into. Outputs are well disguised, and we have had no complaints about our use of this data.

Year and month of birth
